

Paul Casey wins the Shell Houston Open in playoff over J.B. Holmes

April 05, 2009 - Paul Casey of England defeated J.B. Holmes with a bogey in the first playoff on the Redstone Golf Club Tournament Course at the 2009 Shell Houston Open. Casey and Holmes finished 72 holes tied at 11-under-par 277. The victory, Casey's first on the PGA TOUR, moved him to No. 6 in the World Golf Rankings.

For the record Casey shot 66-70-69-72, including a bogey on the 18th hole that dropped him into a tie with clubhouse leader Holmes. Holmes, who shot 71-69-68-69, had to wait for 2 hours and 47 minutes until Casey completed play.

Fan favorite Fred Couples had the tournament lead through the 15th hole on Sunday but finished with three straight bogeys and fell into a tie for third.
